
<u>NOTE:</u> The application fee is \$30 for complete applications received before <u>March 10th</u>. The earlier you apply, the earlier you will hear back. Applications will be accepted after March 31 (\$50 fee) on a space-available basis.

- 2. The CD recording must include the exposition from a concerto, sonata or solo of your choice, plus the following required excerpts (music attached):
 - a. Dvorak Symphony No. 9; trombone 1: Movement 1 start the fifth measure of rehearsal 7, end the fourth measure of rehearsal 8
 - b. Dvorak Symphony No. 9; trombone 1: Movement 2 the first five measures
 - c. Shostakovich Symphony No. 5; trombone 1: Movement 1 3rd measure of rehearsal 29 through rehearsal 31
 - d. Shostakovich Symphony No. 5; trombone 1: Movement 4 start one measure after rehearsal 104 and play for seven measures
 - e. Shostakovich Symphony No. 5; trombone 1: Movement 4 start one measure after rehearsal 111 ending one measure after rehearsal 112
