<u>NOTE:</u> The application fee is \$30 for complete applications received before <u>March 10th</u>. The earlier you apply, the earlier you will hear back. Applications will be accepted after March 31 (\$50 fee) on a space-available basis.

- The CD recording must include the exposition from a concerto, sonata or solo of your choice, plus the following required excerpts (music attached):
  - a. Dvorak Symphony No. 9; tuba: Movement 1 start the fifth measure of rehearsal 11, end the  $9^{th}$  measure of rehearsal 12
  - b. Dvorak Symphony No. 9; tuba: Movement 2 play the first five measures then the last 8 measures of the movement
  - c. Dvorak Symphony No. 9; tuba: Movement 4 play the last 26 measures
  - d. Shostakovich Symphony No. 5; tuba: Movement 2 play one measure before rehearsal 73 to the end of the movement
